PROCESS OF SELECTION

For B.Sc. Nursing Course Atal Medical and Research University will conduct the entrance exam and declare combined and category wise. List based on the marks of the entrance test of all qualified candidates will be prepared and notified. The said merit list will be uploaded on the University website. Merely assigning the rank in this merit list does not confer any right for admission. However, the admission will be made in order of merit as well as fulfilment of the prescribed eligibility criteria on verification of the original certificates/documents and further subject to availability of seat(s) in the concerned quota/category at the time of counseling.

As per the Indian Nursing Council's (INC) Revised Regulations and Curriculum for B.Sc. Nursing Program - Corrigendum, 2022, the minimum qualifying criteria for the entrance test for admission to the B.Sc. Nursing course are as follows

| Category | Percentile |
|-----------------|-----------------|
| General | 50th percentile |
| SC/ST/OBC | 40th percentile |
| General-PwD | 45th percentile |
| SC/ST/OBC - PwD | 40th percentile |

In case of a tie in order of merit, the inter-se ranking of the candidates shall be Decided on the basis of total marks obtained in PCB (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) and there after in order of merit in Biology, Chemistry, Physics and English in 10+2 examination. Even if, there remains a tie after adopting the above procedure then the candidates older in age will be given preference.

For G.N.M. Selection of the candidates shall be made purely on merit basis. The category wise merit shall be drawn by the Director of Medical Education & Research, HP purely on the basis of total marks obtained by the eligible candidates in 10+2 qualifying examination. The first preference shall be given to candidates of 10+2 (Medical Stream: Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English) and in the eventuality of non-availability of eligible candidates of medical stream, second preference shall be given to the candidates of 10+2 (Non-Medical Stream: Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and English) and lastly to the 10+2 (Commerce and Arts stream). However, for determining the eligibility of candidates for final selection, the candidates in order of merit (category-wise) will be called for counseling in the ratio of 1:2 e.g. for filling up 1 seats, Counseling of 2 candidates will be conducted and when total seats are filled-in on the basis of merit of the candidates, the waiting list in each category out of the left out candidates in order of merit shall be drawn. Further, candidates in order of their merit will be afforded with an opportunity to offer their choice in various training institutions depending upon the availability of seats in respective categories.

COUNSELLING:

The date for counselling shall be notified through the Official website, News

Papers, Radio & TV etc. The candidates called for counselling shall produce all the certificates in original before the counselling committee (via Matriculation Certificate for Date of Birth, 10+2 qualifying examination certificate, SC/ST/OBC categories certificate and sub categories certificate i.e. EWS, IRDP, Ex. Serviceman/Ward of Ex-Serviceman, Physically handicapped, Children/Grant Children of Freedom Fighter, Latest Character Certificate and Bonafide certificate issued by the Tehsildar) etc. issued by the competent authority.

PHYSICAL FITNESS

Besides fulfilling the eligibility conditions, the candidate should be certified by Govt. Medical officer as physically and mentally fit to pursue the course.

SYLLABUS

Syllabus for the Two (02) running nursing courses i.e. B.Sc. Nursing & GNM will be followed as per the Atal Medical and Research University (H.P).

EXAMINATION

Semester examination of B.Sc. Nursing & Internal assessment Examination B.Sc. Nursing course will be conducted and respective Degree will be awarded by Atal Medical & Research University Nerchowk, Mandi- HP. Annual examination of GNM is conducted and Diploma for GNM will be awarded by Himachal Pradesh Nurses Registration Council, Shimla.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO EXAMINATION

A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance of Theory and 100% attendance in each of the practical areas.

Note:

- A candidate has to pass in theory and practical exam separately in each of the paper.
- Minimum pass marks shall be 50% in each of the theory and practical separately.
- If candidates fail in either theory or practical paper she has to re-appear for both the papers (theory and practical)
- Maximum number of attempts permitted for each paper is 3 including first attempt.
- The student shall be required to maintain the Practical record book and report of observation visits and diary for assessment must also be used.

ANTIRAGGING MEASURES

As per the Himachal Pradesh Educational Institution (Prohibition Ofragging) Antiragging Act 2011, Ragging is completely prohibited. Also as per direction of the **Honorable Supreme Court of India**, the Government has banned ragging completely in any form inside and outside the campus and authorities are determined not to allow any form of ragging. Whosoever directly or indirectly commits participates in, abets or instigates ragging within or outside Batt College Of Nursing, Bonkhri Mod, will be suspended or rusticated from the Institute and shall also be liable to be fined which may extend to **Rs. 10,000/-**. The punishment may also include suspension from attending the classes, withholding/withdrawing fellow ship and other financial benefits or withholding the result.

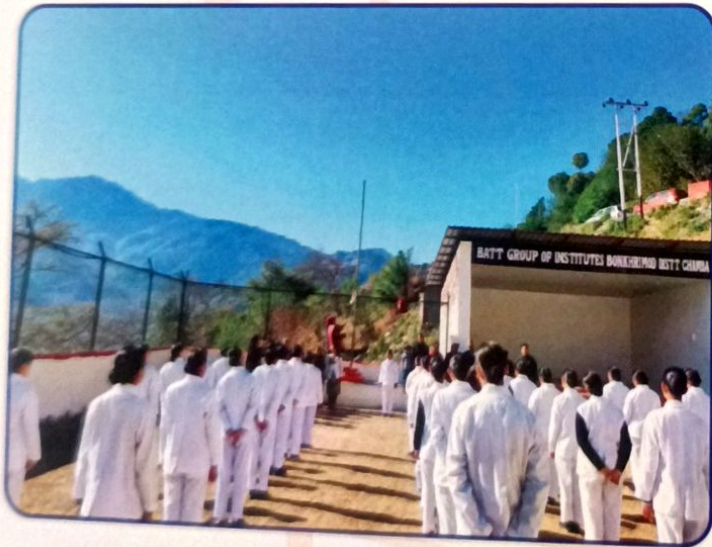

COLLEGE FACILITIES:

1. Class rooms

Classroom in the college have well ventilated and proper lighting. Every classroom has white/green board. Also smart class podium available for rendering smart teaching to the students for advance knowledge and acquired new technique that help for student utilize in not only in field of nursing but also use in other educational field.

2. Library

- Well ventilated and proper lighting in library. It helps for easily accessible to the teaching faculty and the students, during college hours.
- Have comfortable seating arrangements for half of the total strength of the students and teachers.
- Has sufficient number of cupboards, books shelves and racks with glass doors for proper and safe storage of books, magazines, journals, newspapers and other literature.
- Complete collection of text and reference books
- Professional journals and magazines
- Wi-Fi enabled library

3. LABS

a) Nutrition Laboratory:

This lab has facilities for imparting basic knowledge of various methods of cooking for the healthy as well as for the sick. It has furnishing and equipment work-tables, cooking cutlery, trays, and plates, dietetic scales, cooking utensils, racks / shelves, refrigerator, pressure cookers, and cupboards for storage of food items. The food items shall be purchased for the conduct of practical classes as and when required. Sets of crockery and cutlery for preparation, napkins for serving and display of food also available there.

b) Community Health Nursing Lab:

This Lab is well designed and equipped with articles for preparing students to work in Urban and Rural areas in field of community. This lab ensures the students to learn home visiting, bag technique & practice the Community Health Nursing while providing family health care at the door step of the client using modified home visiting.

c) Nursing Foundation Lab:

The lab has well ventilated, fully equipped with demonstration beds with dummies, mannequins in proportion to the number of students practicing a nursing procedure at a given point of time, built-in-cupboards and racks, wash-basins with running water supply, electric fitting, adequate furniture like table, chairs, stools, patient lockers footstools etc. Sufficient Necessary inventory articles needed for the practice of nursing procedure by the students.

d) OBG and Pediatric Nursing lab/ Maternal and Child Health Nursing Lab:

OBG and Pediatric lab is well equipped with various models, charts, demonstration beds with antenatal and postnatal dummies, pediatric beds with pediatric dummies, advance technique based delivery table with mechanism of labor manikin and required items as norm available in this lab for teaching students about stages of pregnancy, care of postnatal mother and her baby.

e) Pre-Clinical Science (Anatomy and Physiology & Microbiology) Lab:

This lab is equipped to teach the students all Microbiology, Biochemistry, Hematological test and also equipped with human body system charts, model and skeletal, so that students have knowledge about all these areas before going to hospital and attend confidently patient.

f) Computer Lab:

Lab is a well ventilated and equipped with 20 computers available for training and practice purposes. This lab will be used by the students to practice the application of computers in the field of nursing.

g) AV AIDS Lab:

The lab is equipped with various electronic devices for the effective teaching & learning such as projectors, OHP, TV, V.C.D., C.D players and Tape Recorders etc.

4) Auditorium/Multipurpose Hall:

Auditorium is spacious enough to accommodate at least double the sanctioned/actual strength of students, so that it is utilized for hosting functions of the college, educational conferences/workshops, examinations etc. It has proper stage, well ventilated and has proper lighting system and arrangements for the use of all kinds of basic and advanced audio-visual aids.

5) Hostels

Hostel accommodation is available for all the students.

Each Hostel has a dining hall with adequate seating capacity for students. Students are under the disciplinary supervision of the Chief Warden and Assistant Wardens and Hostel Supervisor. Staying in Hostel & taking food from the hostel mess is compulsory for all students.

Transportation facilities are available to take the students to various affiliated hospitals for clinical experience and community health nursing in rural and urban areas.

(6) Other Facilities

- Clinical training at renowned hospitals, Government/Private Hospitals, other out- state hospitals and community health centers etc.
- Student guidance and counseling /placement services are available.
- The Managements provides recreational facilities like news paper, magazine, indoor and outdoor games, and other facilities like telephone, first aids kit and doctor on call.
- Every year guaranteed job placements given by the institute to each pass out students.

COLLEGE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Pay your college/ hostel dues as per the prescribed schedule (dates fixed by the college) & notified time to time by the college. Delay in payment beyond due dates will be fined accordingly and consider with late fees only (Minimum 100 per day).
2. The fee/fine and other dues once paid are Not Refundable, Negotiable under any circumstances.
3. Annual DMC's, Course Completion & Relieving Certificate of the students will be issued only after the clearance certificate of all the college/hostel/transportation funds/fine paid by the student for the entire course duration. Students must keep their all the fees paid record ready in case of any conflicts.
4. In case of any breakage of equipment, material either in Hospital, Hostel, Demonstration room, Laboratories etc. concerned students has to bear the cost of the breakage.
5. If the applicant leaves the college before completion of the course, no fee would be refundable, negotiable under any circumstances and students has to pay full amount of the course duration fees.
6. The management, administration of the college has the right to change the fee structure the college fee/funds at any time if required & we shall abide by the changed structure.
7. No mobile phones are allowed in the college.
8. The applicant will not get involved in any kind RAGGING ACTIVITIES if involved will be punished as per the guidelines and laws of state and Central Government, which may mean rustication from the college.
9. Students can avail six leaves for semester excluding Gazetted holidays notified by H.P. apart from the holidays can be sanctioned for any unavoidable circumstances / situations arising at home or with student, if student have more than 95% attendance.
10. All the students have to be deposit the imposed fine within stipulated time period of two days. Otherwise strict action will be taken.
